J. [Moved from Below] Home to School Transportation – Discussion Only Pres. Horn introduced this topic, and the fact that Gravenstein Elementary currently has fewer students than it did several years ago, and noted the fact that nearly 70% of them live outside of the district.

Supt. LaMarre reported that studies have been conducted to evaluate the traffic levels in Twig Ave. As a result, Gravenstein has several start and release times, in an attempt to minimize traffic on Twig Avenue. She also shared that traffic is typically heaviest during the first weeks of school, and that if parents arrive at the designated start and dismissal times, traffic should be minimal. The district provides a directory to all students, by homeroom, as an attempt to put families in touch for carpooling purposes. Also, a community member suggested that the district promote "school pools," a website that helps facilitate the arrangement of carpools.

Mem. Wickland shared that the board has written two letters to the county supervisors, asking that the road conditions be improved on Twig and Lone Pine.

Supt. LaMarre shared that the Gravenstein Back-To-School Nights are on September 1-3, spreading the classes across three nights, in an attempt to reduce traffic.

A community member suggested that carpool lists be available at Back-To-School nights.

Supt. LaMarre reported that she will be focusing on traffic and promoting carpooling in the next district bulletin.

A community member asked that the district request that parents be reminded to not block driveways.

A community member requested that the district remind parents to not park on private property.

A community member asked if the district could limit itself to the students in our district. Supt. LaMarre responded that the district is in limited growth, and the schools have been capped at four classes per grade.

Pres. Horn reviewed that the district will be promoting carpooling, and encouraging all drivers to observe traffic laws, to arrive at their designated times, and be polite to the neighbors.
