Horn about his selection process in selecting the firms to request proposals from. Mem. Weaver inquired to Supt. LaMarre about her knowledge of neighboring district that have recently performed searches, and their recommendations. Mem. Weaver requested that Supt. LaMarre inquire to her peers about their experiences with search firms. Mem. Weaver proposes that there would be two meetings to select the search firm. GUTA President Allie Brown inquired about attending the special meeting.
