1. What are your qualifications for appointment to the Board of Trustees?

I am currently an Associate Professor of Economics at Sonoma State University (SSU). During my seven-plus years at SSU I have served on various governance bodies at Department, School, and University levels. Through my service I have developed a good understanding of how educational governance works, how I can use my talents and perspectives to benefit the committees on which I have served, and how to diplomatically navigate the politics inherent to governance.

2. Why are you interested in serving on the Board?

I am interested in serving on the Board of Trustees for a number of reasons. On a personal level, I currently have three children enrolled in the District, and a fourth to follow. I want to ensure a rich and fulfilling educational experience for my children. However, I don't want this motivation to be perceived as purely self-serving. In fact, the experience of my children is a reflection of the experience of all the students and the overall health of the Gravenstein District. The fact that I will have children in the District for the next 11 years only serves to deepen my feeling of investment. On a professional level, I would like to better understand how the Board functions and influences the direction of the District. As a social scientist I am interested in the way in which institutions shape society and how those institutions are ultimately shaped by the individuals that compose them. Serving on the Board would provide me interesting insights from that perspective. Finally, I am simply interested in becoming more involved in, and providing service to, my community.

3. What do you see as the key issues facing the Gravenstein school district?

Based on the last meeting of the Board and anecdotal discussions with parents, the most immediate issue facing the District, in my mind, is the dual program. There is an understandable urgency to formulate a plan as to what the Enrich/Traditional program will look like in the coming academic years. Because of the need to provide information for the next academic year, I think this topic will be at the forefront of upcoming meetings of the Board. Another key topic is the long-term objectives of the District and how they shape the complexion of the campuses and the experience of the students and teachers. For instance, is there going to be a focus on extensive or intensive growth? What is the roll of the District in the immediate community and the regional community? These questions, and many like them, are ones that should be considered by the Board on a regular basis.

4. What are the most important roles of a Board member? How do you see yourself filling those roles?

The most important role(s) of a Board member is to approach issues objectively with the best interest of students and their families, teachers, and staff in mind. If those parties are happy it is a reflection of a well-functioning district. As an educator, I feel that I have good insight into student well-being, and compassion for the families of students. As an empirical economist, I have been trained to address questions with objectivity and to interrogate assumptions, results, and opinions.

5. How much time and energy will you be able to devote to this position if appointed?

As a graduate student I learned what it takes to be successful in a field where work is never finished. As a professor I have a flexible schedule, which means that I necessarily allocate work to accommodate various competing interests. Because of this I feel confident that I will be able to allocate whatever time is necessary to be successful as a member of the Board. I would not take my duties lightly and would not feel comfortable providing anything but 100% effort.
