We know that students and families may have experienced significant and emotional challenges over the past year and we understand that while many want a quick return to "normal", we must acknowledge and manage the myriad of student experiences. To help students with the transition to the new school year, we will be hosting grade level **Meet-the-Teacher** events. These 30-minute events will be a valuable way for students to reconnect and understand what to expect in this upcoming year.

Parents and students will meet in the courtyard and students will follow their teacher to the classroom. (Students - and anyone entering a building - must wear masks to this event.) Parents will remain in the courtyard for announcements and Gravenstein Staff will be available to assist with online forms or any other questions. Students will be given their Student Name Placard that will be used during daily pick-up.

Classroom/Teacher Assignments

Families will be able to see their child's classroom/teacher assignment through the SchoolWise Parent Portal beginning the morning of Tuesday, August 10. Student Drop-Off and Pick-Up

We will continue with the student drop-off and pick-up procedures that we implemented last spring. Parents will be able to use the drop-off circle for students beginning at 8:00AM. Students should not be dropped off more than 15 minutes prior to the start of their instructional day (listed above). Parents will either remain in their vehicle to drop-off or pick-up, or wait at the designated "Walking" pick-up. We will continue to open the lower basketball court for drop-off and pick-up of select grade levels/times. In order to be prepared for the first day of school, students will receive their Name Placard at the Meet-the-Teacher event.
